Government College, Mahendergarh initially came into existence as a private college, then known as Mahendergarh Degree College with the untiring efforts of Kanod Shiksha Samiti way back in 1966. The beautiful building of the college was constructed on 44 acres of land with the donation raised by the people of this region. The mission of the Managing Committee was to provide undergraduate education to the students of rural background of South Haryana. However, the Managing Committee found itself unable to run it properly because of the financial constraints. It did not want to increase the fee and also pay less to the staff. So they approached the Govt. of Haryana to take over its control. The Govt. acceded to the request of the College Managing Committee and thereafter its nomenclature stood changed to Government College, Mahendergarh on 14th July, 1971.

Advent of globalisation offers many opportunities to the higher education institutes in India and it also expose it to many threats and poses new challenges. The policy makers at the highest level have recognised the imperatives of updating higher education system in India to keep pace with the international trends. Quality is an important requirement to keep higher education in India relevant in the changing scenario. NAAC is an effective step in this direction as it has made quality the defining element of higher education in India. NAAC motivates the college to introspect and gives an opportunity to document strength and challenges, review weaknesses and identify potential threats and help in choosing the path of imparting quality education to the satisfaction of all stakeholders. The college volunteered to undergo assessment by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council by submitting its self-study reports in 2002 and 2017, and it was accredited with grade 'B'. Based on the suggestions and recommendations of NAAC peer team report, the college has taken many initiatives for both horizontal and vertical expansion of the college. The college has established IQAC on 04/05/2011 and since then it is functioning effectively suggesting and monitoring quality aspects.

The location of the college no doubt is in semi rural area. But for all intents and purposes it is a rural college for more than 80% students hails from the rural areas. Presently, the college offers undergraduate degree courses in Arts, Commerce and Science streams and Post graduate Courses in M.A. (English) and M.A. (Hindi). In the current session (2023-24) there are around 2500 students on the rolls of the college. The college is co-educational, allowing both male and female students to study together. The college is now affiliated to Indira Gandhi University, Meerpur, Rewari. It also got its recognition by the U.G.C. under 2(f) and 12-B in 1967.

Presently, the college is spread over about 24 acres with sports ground and auditorium. Our motto, "Jyotisha Badhate Tamah", ज्योतिषा बाधते तमः meaning 'Light Prevents Darkness' motivates us to always work with honesty and dedication to enlighten ourselves and contribute to the society's awakening and welfare. We provide opportunities to students from different streams to mingle together in academic as well as sports, cultural and other extra-curricular activities. Women cell of the college sensitizes the girl students and society regarding gender based issues by organizing different activities. It also provides supportive environment to girls for their overall development. The college encourages its faculty to participate in seminars/conferences and promote holistic teaching and learning.
